



- 1. All bleed (Approximately 10mm bleed on each 4 side must be included in the ad image supplied from you.)
- 2. Booking deadline: 60 days prior to the publication date
- 3. Copy deadline: 20 days prior to the publication date
- 4. Trademarks, company logos, pictures should be placed more than 10 mm inside for printing reason.
- 5. All ads must be submitted in the digital format. Please ask your Asahi Shimbun representative for details.
- 6. Discount rates are applied if you place an insertion order for at least 6 placements of ads (1 placement per month) for 6 months and over.
- 7. An advertisement must comply with The Asahi Shimbun's Advertising Acceptability Standards.

- 8. The manuscript is required to be made of PDF data.
- 9. Corner marks are needed in the manuscript. Corner marks are composed of trim marks (printed size) and bleed marks (printed size + each side 3mm). Ground color should reach bleed marks.
